Every student, teacher, and visitor participating or observing in certain laboratories, shops and other courses shall wear an eye-protective device furnished by the school while working with hazardous materials, machines, or activities:

1. Molten metal or other molten materials
2. Milling, sawing, turning, shaping, cutting, grinding, or stamping on any solid materials
3. Heat treatment, tempering or kiln-firing of any metal or other materials
4. Gas or electric and welding other forms of welding processes
5. Repairs or servicing of any vehicle
6. Caustic or explosive materials
7. Finishing materials and solvents
8. Injurious radiations or other hazards

Teachers and students who operate a kiln with an automatic shut-off do not need to use eye protective devices.

An adequate number of eye-protective devices shall be available in the lab, shop and classroom for students, teachers and visitors.
